

## The Greek Sale, 6 Dec 2016

The 6 Dec 2016 Cypria Greek Sale concludes a fantastic year for our boutique auction house with the sale achieving a 55% by lot and a 69% by value success rate.

The top lot for the evening was the exceptional work *Affiches Massicotees* from 1962 by Pavlos (Dionyssopoulos), realizing 35.355 euro.

Other noteworthy highlights of the evening were *Hydra* by Nikos Hadjikyriakos-Ghika and *Interior with stove* by Nikolaos Gysis which were sold for 21.213 and 14.142 euro respectively. *Flowers* by Thanos Tsingos sold for 8.249 euro, *Erotic* by Yiannis Moralis sold for 5.892 euro and *Waiting for the enemy* by Nikitas Grispos sold for 5.892 euro.

A *coral and diamond brooch* previously owned by Maria Callas sold for 14.142 euro and a 1950's *sapphire and diamond earrings and ring ensuite* by Vourakis sold for 23.570 euro.
