





Betty Mbitjana paints patterns based on footprints in the sand created during ceremonial dances, designs that are typically painted on women's bodies. Her images are largely homages to her ancestors and the traditions of her tribe.

Artist's description of the Waterholes Artworks: "I have painted waterholes in my country at sunrise — to the north of Mantinea Flats near Kununurra, Western Australia. The flatlands have plenty of waterholes and after the wet, they fill right up. The waterholes are all different colours, just depends on what's underneath them. Some are very salty because all this country used to be under seawater long time ago —they're the white ones. The black, they've still got a bit of water in them but no good to drink. The yellow coloured ones are where the good water is, bit of sand but water ok. The green ones look pretty—they have water all year long from under the ground (natural spring water) and the sun makes the top of the water all green with leaves

and bits of grass soaking in the water for a long time. This is a really good place for animals and bush tucker most of the year, and my mother and grandmother used to walk all around and lived off this land"

Ju Ju Wilson is of the Miriwoong people and her Aboriginal name is Burriwee. She was born in Kimberley, Western Australia. Apart from being an artist she is an expert in bush tucker, bush medicines and a much sought-after cultural advisor who has made numerous appearances on television regarding these topics. Her paintings and artefacts are collected worldwide.

Martin Giesen was born in 1945 in Germany. Martin Giesen started to paint at age 15. After school he studied art history at Heidelberg University. For a year (1970-71) he interned at the Metropolitan Museum of Art in New York followed by completion of a PhD (Universität Heidelberg 1973).

With marriage and children, Giesen entered into a career of university teaching. He has taught history of art and architecture in Lebanon (AUB 1973-85), Saudi Arabia, Canada, and since 1997 in the United Arab Emirates, where he was founding dean of the School of Architecture & Design at the American University of Sharjah. For some 40 years, Giesen has produced and exhibited watercolour paintings documenting

the impact of development on the environment.

His paintings produced in Lebanon during the years of the civil war received critical acclaim. Giesen is now retired and lives on the island of Cyprus. Work has been shown in solo exhibits in Lebanon, Germany, Canada, and the United Arab Emirates. David Tannous, Washington corresponding editor for Art in America, called Giesen a "contemporary orientalist". John Munro and Samir Sayegh authored monographs, published in 1984 and 1995, on Giesen's Lebanese watercolours.

"Martin Giesen's watercolours have been achieving high prices at auctions in the last few years with some works reaching hammer prices of over 15,000 Euro".







The painting most likely depicts an idealized view of the Bay of Jounieh in Lebanon from the North.

Johann Andreas Von HERRENBURG was born in Berlin in 1824 and died there in 1906. He studied in the Berlin academy under Professor Karl Eduard Biermann. Herrenburg was principally known as an architectural and landscape artist. In 1845 he travelled to Greece and the following year in

1846 to Asia Minor, Persia, Syria and Cyprus. Whilst in Cyprus he drew the first complete map of the Orient. During the year of 1847 he travelled to Egypt and Abyssinia before returning to Berlin. On his return journey he visited Italy and Paris, France. In 1848, he travelled to England where he rented a studio in Kensington, London and stayed until 1855 at which time he returned to Germany.





Baccarat Crystal since it was founded in 1764 in the town of Baccarat, France has been producing high-end exclusive crystal products and is unquestionably one of the top crystal brands in the world.

Many of the lots been offered at our auction (the glasses, the water pitchers and some of the wine decanters) belong to the same Baccarat pattern called "Vienne Gold Trim".
