





NOTE

Dinos Michaelides was born in Paphos in 1934. His innate talent in sculpture became apparent from his early childhood years. He went on to study Fine Arts (Sculpture), Economics and Business Administration in Lebanon, England and Greece and holds BA, BBA, MA and Ph.D. Degrees.

In his career he has worked as a High School teacher and as a Government Officer with the Ministry of Finance in Cyprus for 2I years until his early retirement, to go private. He has been President for 15 years of the International Real Estate Federation (FIABCI) and a representative of the Federation at the United Nations in Geneva. Presently he is the President and Managing Director of his own Group of Companies and a Board member of many Professional Associations and Philanthropic Institutions and Organizations in Cyprus and Oversea Countries.

The sculptures created by Dinos Michaelides have "woman" as their main theme. He portrays women in his own unique



style which encompasses erotism and a sense of humor and makes his work instantly recognizable.

The sculpture currently offered at the Cypria auction is a very good example of his work. Dinos Michaelides' work has been shown in numerous solo and group exhibitions.

Worth a mention is that Dinos Michaelides is the father of the well-known journalist and TV presenter Elita Michaelidou.







NOTES

The battle of the Hydaspes River (Η Μάχη στον Υδάσπη ποταμό) took place in 326 BC.

Here, Alexander the Great's victory against King Porus of the Indian kingdom of Pauravas on the banks of the Hydaspes River in Pentapotamia resulted in the expansion of the Macedonian empire beyond the already defeated Persian empire.

Jean Philibert LEFEBVRE painted this in 1789 based on Charles Le Brun's original. Charles Le Brun was commissioned by Louis XIV of France in the 17th century to create a series of paintings about Alexander the Great. These today can be seen in the "Hall of the History of Alexander" in the Louvre Museum.

NOTES

The Battle of Gaugamela also known as the Battle of Arbela (H Máxŋ των Γαυγαμήλων ή Máxŋ στα Άρβηλα) was the last, biggest, and most decisive battle of Alexander the Great against Darius in 331 BC. This was the final battle between the two kings and is considered to be the final blow to the Achaemenid Empire, resulting in its complete conquest by Alexander. The fighting took place in Gaugamela, a village on the banks of the river Bumodus. The area today is known as modern-day Erbil in Iraq.

Jean Philibert LEFEBVRE painted this in 1790 based on Charles Le Brun's original. Charles Le Brun was commissioned by Louis XIV of France in the 17th century to create a series of paintings about Alexander the Great. These today can be seen in the "Hall of the History of Alexander" in the Louvre Museum.






Christoforos Savva was born in Marathovouno in 1924 and died in Sheffield in 1968.

After serving in the Cypriot Regiment of the British Army during World War II he moved to London for studies at St. Martin's School of Art and the Central School of Art, before enrolling at Heatherley School of Art where he studied until 1953. During the next two years he spent time in Cyprus, where he presented his first solo exhibitions and became involved in the local artistic milieu, while also being one of the founders of the Pancyprian Union of Art Votaries. In 1956, he returned to London and later moved to Paris for further studies at the Académie Montparnasse, under André L'hote.

The end of the decade found Savva settling in Nicosia where he quickly established himself as one of the leading artists in a vibrant art scene, both through his own art practice and through the activities of "Apophasis" [Decision] Gallery, Nicosia. "Apophasis" which he founded in 1960 in collaboration with Welsh artist Glyn Hughes, was the first independent cultural centre of the newly founded Republic of Cyprus. As a space where creative synergy and exchange could take place, the gallery was soon to become the epicentre of intellectual and cultural activity on the island, hosting numerous exhibitions, lectures, plays and film screenings. In 1968, Savva was one of the six artists selected to represent Cyprus in its inaugural Pavilion at the Venice Biennale. Just a few weeks after the opening, he died suddenly in Sheffield, UK.

He is considered one of the most influential modernist Cypriot artists of his time having taken part in several important exhibitions, in 1958 at Mariac Gallery and Jordan Gallery in Paris, in 1960 in Beirut, in 1967 at the Panhellenic Exhibition; in 1968 at Venice Biennale, in 1962 at "Art in the Commonwealth Today" exhibition which took place at Commonwealth Institute in London; in 1970 at "Contemporary Cypriot Art" at Commonwealth Institute in London; in 1979 at "Demetria" of Thessaloniki and at "Contemporary Cypriot Painting" at Athens National Gallery. After his death, seven posthumous exhibitions were organized by the Cultural Services of the Ministry of Education and Culture, the latest being the representation of Cyprus in the Venice Biennale in 2019 with a retrospective of Savva's work.

His work can be found in public and private collections in Cyprus; at the State Gallery of Contemporary Cypriot Art; Nicosia Municipality; Cultural Centre of Popular Bank; Bank of Cyprus Cultural Centre.

Alexandrakis graduated from The School of Fine Art, Athens in 1937, having won all the major art awards; those of Portrait, Nude, Semi-nude and Composition.

His achievements are considered unique in the history of the annual prize of the school.

Alexandrakis is an artist of international repute, having forged a strong reputation in the USA where he regularly submitted works to The Guggenheim in New York for its annual exhibition.

In 1950 he submitted two works for the design of a poster for the Marshall Plan, organized by the American Government. He won the first and second prize. Seascape is a rare thematic work for Alexandrakis, the turbular nature of the sea and skyscape of the work perhaps reflects the mood of the veteran artist after having served in the Second World War.

The artist starts by creating a basic sketch of the idea he has for the final work. He then takes an Ultra Violet (UV) photograph of the sketch and prints the photograph on a special Gesso paper. He then sets about creating the final work by painting over the Gesso paper at various stages alternating between painting and using other substances applied to the paint until he achieves the final result.



George Kotsonis was born at Paleochori, Cyprus, in 1940. Between 1958 to 1967 he studied at the Saint Martin's School of Art in London, at the Academy of Fine Arts of Professor Ai-Choun-Sin's workshop in China, and at the Academy of Fine Arts in Prague.

Kotsonis' work consists of paintings, mosaics, and prints. He lives and works in Paphos where some of the most important roman mosaics can be found. He extensively studied these mosaics and was influenced by them, making him thus one of the few Cypriot artists who mastered the technique of mosaics.

> Kotsonis has accomplished some of the most monumental contemporary mosaics like the outstanding mural "The preachery of the Apostles in Paphos", 1986, 300 x 500 cm at the building of the Paphos Holy Bishopric.
